Cookies Notice

I. WHAT TECHNOLOGIES ARE USED?

We use cookies and tracking pixels. Cookies are small files that your browser saves on your computer or mobile device when visiting our website. This allows the Internet site to recognize your computer the next time you visit us. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

Cookies on our website are not aimed at spying on users and do not follow everything the user does and are not malicious code or virus. Tracking pixels are graphics with dimensions of 1x1 pixels that are loaded when visiting a website.

II. TYPES OF COOKIES

You have different types of cookies depending on their function, duration or source.

Cookies by function

a) Technical (necessary) cookies

Necessary cookies enable core functionality such as security, network management, and accessibility. These cookies are essential for the functioning of the website and cannot be excluded. You can set your browser to block these cookies or send a warning about them, but in this case some parts of the page will not work. Those cookies do not store any information that might identify you, so we do not need your consent.

b) Functional cookies

These cookies enable the Internet site to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. These cookies allow the website to remember information such as your language settings or the region you are in. We need your consent to use functional cookies.

c) Analytics/Statistical cookies

We'd like to set analytics cookies to help us improve our website by collecting and reporting information on how you use it. We use these purely for internal research on how we can improve the service we provide for all our users. The cookies simply assess how you interact with our website – as an anonymous user. These cookies collect anonymous information, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited. The cookies collect information in a way that does not directly identify anyone. These will be set only if you accept.

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors on the website and display content that is relevant to them. Our



d) Marketing cookies

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors on the website and display content that is relevant to them. Our website does not use marketing cookies.

Cookies by duration

Depending on your preferences, we can use only session cookies or both (session or persistent cookies).

a) Session cookies

Session or temporary cookies are removed from your computer after you close your Internet browser. Through them, Internet sites store temporary data, such as items in the shopping basket if you are buying tickets through our website.

b) Persistent cookies

Persistent cookies are cookies saved on your computer which are not deleted automatically when you close your browser, unlike a session cookie. Persistent cookies are only used to re-identify you upon your next visit. These cookies are used to store information, such as language preferences, or cookies preferences so that you do not have to enter them again during each next visit.

Cookies by Source

a) First party cookies

First party cookies are cookies set by the website you are visiting and can be session or persistent, depending on your preferences. Only that website can read them. With these cookies, we can store data you will use again the next time you visit this website.

b) Third party cookies

Third party cookies come from other Internet sites, which are on the Internet site you are watching. This includes their cookie policies, which we have no control over. Our website does not use third party cookies.

III. TYPE OF PIXELS

We use Pixels on our website for statistical purposes only. They are used to track the activity of a user on a website. When you visit our website, the pixel sends a request to a server to record your activity. This request is typically sent in the form of an HTTP request, and it may include information such as the user's IP address, the time and date of the request, and the type of web browser being used (not y.



IV. HOW TO MANAGE COOKIES AND PIXELS

If you want to disable cookies and pixels, you can refuse it through the provided settings on our website or you can use your browser settings. The only type of cookies you cannot turn off are **necessary** cookies.

To disable cookies and pixels through the settings provided on or website, you can set the slider/checkmark to "Off" at any time and then click "Save and Close".

To disable cookies and pixels through your browser, please note that most internet browsers are set to accept cookies and pixels by default. However, if you wish to refuse or delete them, please refer to the help and support area of your browser for instructions on how to block or delete them. For example, some of the relevant links are: Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Android Browser and the like.

Please note that each browser has a different procedure for managing and setting cookies and pixels. However, if you use your browser settings to block, for example all cookies (including essential cookies), you may not be able to access all or some parts of our website or service.
